

She enjoyed doing so, and is extremely thankful for this opportunity, and we pray that the Lord used her to somehow touch someone's heart that was able to be in attendance. We are glad that we were able to have made this trip and are still gleaming from the messages our hearts were able to receive while there.

During this trip, we were able to be featured live on WTBI radio! It was quite a fun experience that none of us will soon forget. We are thankful for the opportunity to be with them, present the work the Lord has given us and have the young men be able to share songs, testimonies and verses from the Word of God. We pray that we were able to be a blessing to someone out there listening.

Project Status Updates

This past month we were finally able to get the roof on the main building replaced. Praise the Lord! This has been such a blessing already! We are so thankful to all those that gave towards this need.



The project is not completely finished, as there are still more roofs to eventually be done, once the funds allow. However, the main building is complete and we are so grateful. Unfortunately though, it was not without slight error. During the replacement, a portion of our porch roof collapsed. Thankfully, no one was hurt! We are now looking to demolish the existing porch as it is no longer considered stable. Please pray for us in this project that it may be done safely and efficiently.

As mentioned in our last letter, in attempts to avoid the recent significant price increase in HVAC units, after much prayer and consideration, we made the decision to proceed in borrowing the money necessary to purchase the remainder of the HVAC units needed. We are continuing to ask the Lord to provide the donated funds to help cover this expense. We are still in need of \$20,000 in relation to this need.



Another area in which we are praying for God to provide, is in relation to insurance. As you are probably aware, insurance is a necessity in order for a ministry such as ours to remain in operation. That being said, it is not a cheap expenditure in the least. Unfortunately, we were unable to pay for the full year's coverage up-front, and rather opted to pay dues monthly instead. This cost is roughly \$1,500/month, totaling approximately \$18,000/year.

We are also looking into obtaining a commercial-grade washing machine. As you can imagine, we generate many loads of laundry daily here. With as frequently as the washing machines, commercial-grade is becoming a necessity. The prices we have seen thus far range between \$1,600 to \$1,800.

Please join us in prayer that the Lord will provide for these great needs. We are looking forward to seeing how the Lord chooses to honor our humble requests.
